2022-2023 Greater Charlotte USBC Association Senior Championship Tournament Rules

1. The Greater Charlotte USBC Association (GCUSBC) Senior Championship Tournament is certified by USBC and will abide by its rules and those stated in regard to this tournament.
2. This is a singles handicap event only open to all bowlers 50 years of age and older who are members of the GCUSBC. Non GCUSBC Association members must pay applicable national and/or state and/or local dues. Entrants must have reached their 50th birthday on or before 3/1/23. Entrants must present their 2022-2023 USBC membership card and a valid ID as proof of age. Event will have male and female divisions.
3. Entering Average:
 - a. Highest USBC certified winter or summer yearbook average based on 21 games or more for the 2021-2022 season.
 - b. A bowler with no 2021-2022 yearbook average or summer 2022 average shall use their current 2022-2023 average based on 21 games as of 1/1/2023. Proof of average must be provided with entry. If neither (a) nor (b) bowler will bowl scratch.
4. All bowlers will be required to adjust their average if they meet the criteria of USBC Rules 319a thru 319e. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$300 - \$1,000 in any tournament (certified or non-certified) in the past 12 months shall report the amount of prize and score for possible re-rating. Such re-rating must be accomplished before the entrant may bowl. If re-rate is not acceptable by the entrant, the entry fee will be refunded. If winnings of \$300 or more are not reported the bowler will be disqualified.
5. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average prior to the start of the tournament. Failure to use proper average will disqualify bowler
6. Handicap will be 90% of 220.
7. Entrants may participate one time only.
8. All prize fees collected will be returned 100% to participants.
9. Confirmations will be sent via email or US Postal Service.
10. All winners (male and female) in each class will have their entry fee refunded once they have entered and participated in the NCS USBC **2023/2024** Senior Tournament. All event winners must verify their age. Must receive the required information two weeks after NCS USBC **2023/2024** Senior Tournament is over.
11. Age Classifications: Class "A": 70 years of age or older; Class "B": 65 to 69 years of age; Class "C": 60 to 64 years of age; Class "D": 55 to 59 years of age; and Class "E": 50 to 54 years of age.
